

How to Make a Giant Bow

Looking for the perfect way to wrap up your new Springfree Trampoline? We've got just the ticket! Just follow these simple steps:

Materials Needed

- Flat surface
- Scissors
- Wire
- Measuring tape
- 3-4 bolts of ribbon -we used 21in x 30ft (53cm x9m) bolts of red mesh
- A friend



Step 1

Measure and cut your ribbon

For a 4ft (1m) bow you'll need:

10ft (3m) long piece x3

8ft (2m) long piece x2

Step 2

Cut your wire



Cut wire into 10 pieces that are 12in (30cm) long.

Step 3

Ribbon Folding

Fold a 10ft (3m) piece of ribbon in half.

Mark the Center.

Fold either end of the ribbon to the center ensuring they overlap 2in-4in (5cm-10cm).

Step 4

Shaping the bow

Cinch together where the ribbon is overlapped in the center and secure with wire.



Step 5

Repeat

Repeat step 4 with another 10ft (3m) piece of ribbon.

Step 6

Layering



Angle the 10ft (3m) pieces of ribbon on top of each other.

Secure with wire.

Step 7

Repeat

Repeat steps 3 to 6 with your 8ft (2m) pieces of ribbon.

You will now have two bows.



Step 8

Final Layer



Place the smaller bow on top of and in the center of the larger bow.

Secure them together with wire.

Step 9

Assembly

Take your third piece of 10ft (3m) long ribbon and fold it in half.

Wrap the center around the middle of your bow. Secure it with wire.



Step 10

Mounting



Have one person hold the bow in place in between two enclosure rods.

Using wire, affix the bow on either side to the enclosure rods.

Step 11 (optional)

Added Touch

For an extra touch wrap the ribbon around your trampoline net.

Use wire to attach either end of the ribbon to the center of your bow once it's wrapped around the net.

**Note: If you choose not to use this option, you can reduce the amount of ribbon bolts required by one.*
